The Institute provides specialized training in Natural Resources Management and Tourism Development in an effort to enhance Conservation, Management and Sustainability of Wildlife Biodiversity in Kenya and Globally. It offers training at Certificate and Diploma levels in collaboration with Local Universities, Research Institutions, International and Local NGOs.

The courses are competency based and will be offered in modules reflecting industry deployments.
